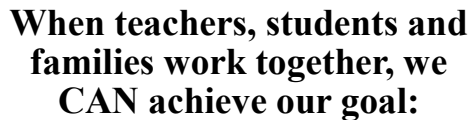

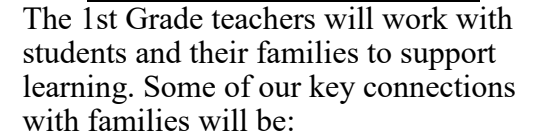


District Goal:

- During the 2021-2022 School Year 80% of ELA teachers will demonstrate use of the collaborative common assessment process to increase student achievement. (Erkens)
- During the 2021-2022 School Year 80% of Math teachers will demonstrate use of the collaborative common assessment process to increase student achievement. (Erkens)
- During the 2021-2022 School Year 80% of Science teachers will demonstrate use of the collaborative common assessment process to increase student achievement. (Erkens)

- In ELA our grade level will focus on reading grade level text fluently.
- In Math our grade level will focus on addition and subtraction facts to 10.
